

Agreed upon Operating Procedures for upcoming season/games:

- Games will be held on Saturday's
- Team with the best record will host Superbowl (last week of the season)
- To cut costs; hosting team will acquire 1 qualified (adult) head referee, and 2 additional refs (can be HS aged)
- Gate fee is \$3 for students/families 13 & up; 12 and under free; coaches and players free
- Game time: 4 - 10 minute running clock, 3 timeouts per half, last 4 minutes of 4th quarter start & stop clock as normal football game if score is within 2 scores (12 points)
- Half time is 10 minutes, Ties follow Kansas City overtime
- In OT each team will get equal possession to score on 20 yard line with 4 downs to score
- Kickoff twice during the game; start of the 1st quarter & start of 3rd quarter
- Punts must be declared in advance for time management; if punt declared football is moved 20 yards from the scrimmage line
- Any ball carrier must be 120 lbs or below; Tight Ends weighing more than 120 can receive/catch/intercept but may not advance the ball
- Players over 120 lbs must have an "X" on both sides of their helmet
- All games are local time of the hosting team
- Please provide rosters game day or prior if possible
